BIRD ORDER UPDATE



We've had some big changes when it comes to placing your bird orders online at <u>NCWNAVHDA.org/bird-orders</u>.

In March, we were able to automate the process so you receive a confirmation email immediately upon placing your order. This update has been an enormous timesaver for our dedicated bird man, Brian Werner — who not only has been volunteering for **THIRTEEN YEARS** to coordinate, manage, and maintain our pigeon sources, but has also been responsible for responding to individual bird order emails/requests for years. Anything we can do to help him is worth it to us!

In April, we took it a step further and now offer the option to pay for bird orders online. You can continue to pay with cash or check at pick-up on training day if you prefer - just select the Offline Payment button during checkout. For folks who choose to pay online, just check-in at the bird pen table before collecting your birds.

These updates also mean you will know what bird prices are and what your total is upon ordering — so you can come extra prepared when training day rolls in.

We hope you are enjoying these updates as much as we are!

MEMBER FAVORITES

We asked our Vice President, Desi Stormont, what one of her favorite wild game recipes is -- she was quick with her response, sharing this <u>Hank Shaw recipe for</u> <u>Pheasant Piccata!</u>



"For anyone looking to venture into the world of wild game, but you're trying to think outside of the "cream of something" box, Hank Shaw's Pheasant Piccata is hands down one of my favorite pheasant recipes. The sauce from this recipe is citrusy and sour, which gives a great balance to the pheasant and compliments it so well. Even those who don't "love" wild game will be impressed by this flavor profile. I love to serve this over some buttery mashed potatoes with a side of green beans. Top it off with a nice chilled white wine and some chat about that fall hunt that brought this bird to the table! " -- Desiree Stormont

PHEASANT PICATTA

- 4 to 8 pheasant, chicken, partridge or grouse breasts *skinless and boneless*
- Salt and black pepper
- 1/2 cup flour
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- 1/4 cup unsalted butter, divided
- 1/2 cup white wine
- 2 tablespoons lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons small capers
- 2 tablespoons chopped parsley



- Put each breast between two sheets of plastic wrap and pound them flat with a rubber mallet, empty wine bottle or meat mallet. You want them about 1/4 inch thin if you can. Better to err on being too thick than thin. Salt and pepper the cutlets well and dust with the flour. White flour is traditional here, but I like to pair darker flours with game, so I use whole wheat, rye or spelt flour.
- Get the oil and half of the butter hot over medium high heat, and saute to the floured breasts for 3 minutes on one side, 2 minutes on the other. You may need to do this in batches. Move to a plate and tent with foil.
- Pour in the lemon juice and white wine and scrape any brown bits off the bottom of the pan with a wooden spoon. Add the capers and boil this down by half over high heat, maybe 2 minutes. Turn off the heat and put the pheasant breasts on serving plates. Put the remaining butter in the saute pan and swirl it around until it melts. The sauce should be emulsified and smooth. Pour over the pheasant and garnish with the parsley.
